

„New Job” Scheme

The aim of the "New job" scheme is to provide incentives for employers in Bulgaria to recruit young unemployed people under 29 years, giving them support for investment costs and labor costs associated with the creation of new jobs.

Eligible are costs for payment of remuneration in the amount of the minimal income for the specific economic activity and occupation. Eligible are also payments on social security, and transportation costs when the training is held in different location.

Employers will be able to enjoy a subsidy of up to 40% of eligible direct costs to equip the jobs that will provide for young people. This scheme is an opportunity for the labor market integration of young people with disabilities whose participation in employment is hindered by the need for employers to make investments for adaptation or redesigning of relevant jobs.

Expected results: 1,300 people will be involved in trainings to acquire or enhance their professional qualifications. 900 people will be trained for acquisition of key competences and 2,000 people will be offered employment after the training.
