To give young talent a chance, employers can publish a apprenticeship at WeLP. WeLP database is a tool where companies can offer apprenticeships, and where schools can find the suitable apprenticeships for their students.

When the new dual learning starts, this database is the place where the first match between business and younger can be made. Through very clearly describing the offered work placement, what training a company can offer, which the competencies that can be developed with them, schools can very specifically seek out the most suitable apprenticeships for the young person, depending on his / her talents.

Screened candidates are then referred to the employer, who then chooses the ideal candidate to gain experience in his or her business. It can take many different forms, ranging from an internship as part of training to individual training.
