

Scheme "First job"

Applicants must be unemployed are under 29 years of age, registered with labor offices and when included in vocational training and a minimum required level of education under national law. To participate in the scheme, unemployed young people must submit an application to the employment office, after which they will be directed to appropriate for them vacancy announced by the employer wishing to join the scheme. Training for professional qualification no restrictions, and training for key competencies young people will be able to choose between training in foreign languages, mathematical competence, digital competence and learning skills. The trainings are funded with vouchers, and if the training takes place in a location different from the place of residence of the young, he or she will receive funds for travel to the place of training. In addition, for each school day will be applied scholarship in the amount of 8 lev per day for 6 hours.



Employers wishing to hire unemployed youths under the scheme must submit an application to the Employment Office. They will receive a grant to cover the salaries and costs for by social security. The amount of subsidy is equal to the minimum social security threshold for the economic activity and occupation, and can be used for 6-12 months.

Expected results: 700 people will be involved in trainings to acquire or improve their professional qualification. 1630 people will participate in training for acquisition of key competences, and 2100 people will be offered employment after training.
